## **1. Chapter of First Encounter**

### **Chunhyang and Mongnyong – Korea’s Romeo and Juliet**

## **2. Chapter of Vows**

### **Where an Everlasting Love was Born**

Do you see the ring-shaped structure at the entrance? It's where the Chapter of Vows, the second chapter of Chunhyang Theme Park, begins. This area includes the Fence of Love, Fence of Vows, Altar of Vows, and a swing, each representing the couple's everlasting love.

What is the "Altar of Vows"? As its name suggests, it is a place for couples who want to pledge their undying love. The altar is surrounded by stone sculptures describing scenes from the story of Chunhyang and has a heart-shaped “vow plaque”. Couples can place their hands on this plaque to make a vow, and a tone will sound blessing their love. This is perhaps the most intriguing place for couples in love. Don't forget to leave a padlock of love at the bridge before you move on. In Ponte Vecchio, Italy, couples leave a padlock on the bridge rail to promise their devotion, a practice which has become popular around the world. So why not do something memorable here with the one you love as a celebration of your relationship?

## **3. Chapter of Love and Forced Separation**

### **Separation from the Loved One**

This is the third chapter of Chunhyang Theme Park, and the most trying part of the story. It is also where you can see a variety of filming locations. There are traditional houses including Chunhyang's House and a village school, and Korean traditional furniture items are on display as well. In particular, Chunhyang's room, called Buyongdang, is where the couple spent their first night together.

But their happiness was short lived. After a short period of blissful rendezvous, the two were left with no choice but to part ways. His father was a local administrator and was dispatched to another province, so he had to leave town with his family. He promised her he would return a successful man and she watched him leave. She never doubted his return.
